UNDER LOCK AND KEY

This Marylebone pad will give you an added sense of security - it was here that the world's first unpickable lock was invented. Shape Real Estate and Boultsbee LDN have separated the old locksmiths into three four-bed properties, with interiors designed by Stiff + Trevillion in a style that stays true to the building's industrial heritage. ARCHITECTURAL ABODE

Starchitect Rabih Hage has sprinkled his magic on this 19th-century building, which was originally designed by George Godwin as part of the master plan for what is now known as The Boltons Conservation Area. In addition to the five bedrooms and six bathrooms, there is a swish fitness facility with an inky black pool.
